1. Welcome and apologies

2. Note of last meeting

School meals standards review regulations – Susan will find out progress on this. **Action: Susan**

3. Glasgow City Food Plan Update

Jill provided an update on progress with the (now named) Glasgow City Food Plan. She advised that the development day was confirmed for 9th December in the Tontine Building, Argyle Street, and that all the leads would be sent a paper outlining what was required.

There were around 70 people signed and, after this, it is expected that the sub groups will continue to meet individually to advance the plan.

4. Food Plan Communications & Engagement Strategy

Jill gave an update on the communications and engagement strategy work and there was discussion on the logo and branding. Jill will take forward the suggestions on how to refine the design. **Action: Jill**

In terms of promotion it was felt that it would be useful to engage with existing groups and opportunities to spread awareness. For example, Abi will be giving a talk at the North Glasgow Community Food Initiative.

Other activities suggested :

- Working directly with one or more journalists for more in depth coverage
- Asking sub groups members to highlight and promote the Plan development

Andrew advised that an application for a Knowledge Exchange Bid had been submitted that included a request for funds in relation to the plan.

Engagement will be sought with Councillors and MSPs and links also made with:

- The Good Food Nation Bill
- Food Standards Scotland
- Community Planning

5. Terms of Reference

Jill advised that this had been revised in light of earlier comments. An additional comment was to change the reference to Cordia as this no longer exists as a standalone organisation. **Action: Jill**
