1. Welcome and apologies

3. Glasgow City Food Plan

Plan development:

The draft Plan has been circulated to critical friends and comments have been incorporated.

Next stage send plan to GCC Glasgow City Council consultation team for launch from 29 September 2020 -22 December 2020.

There will be an online launch event on 8 October.

Also being worked on are measures and indicators for post-consultation - Ideally these will link with GCC'S 2030 carbon reduction indicators.

Communications:

Riikka advised that the GCPH coms team had been very helpful with events planning etc. and she will work with partner organisations for the collective launch. A comms tool kit is being worked on and press coverage being sought. Siobhan advised that she will be meeting with reps from Health Improvement Localities and they have plans for community engagement work. Everyone was encouraged help publicise the launch within and outwith their organisations and networks. 4. Vote on GFPP becoming constituted; next steps

Riikka advised that out of a possible 14, 8 had voted yes and one was unsure. Some national body reps commented that they felt it was more appropriate for local partners.

Next steps are to decide on a legal structure. Sara Davies and Ben Messer from SFP network have offered to help with the decision.

Louise, Riikka, Abi, Siobhan and Deidre volunteered to join a short life working group which Riikka will co-ordinate.

5. Vote on Glasgow applying for SFP award

8 out of 14 voted yes. Riikka will register interest and liaise with SFP network. It was suggested that it might be a good project for a Masters student.

6. Potential Meeting with the Aileen Campbell

Nourish with Food Coalition have been in touch with Aileen Campbell, Minister for Communities and Local Government, to arrange a meeting which GFPP also has a chance to participate in. Anna Richardson was suggested as a good person to represent GFPP, and we are waiting for the date for the meeting to be confirmed.
